DCBA Privacy and Communication Policy

The Davie County Beekeepers Association (DCBA) respects the privacy of all its members. The DCBA implements a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information.

The DCBA collects information from and maintains information about you when you become a member of the DCBA. This information includes your name, postal address, phone numbers, email addresses, primary local affiliate chapter, and other personal information. This information is used solely by the DCBA and is not shared, traded, or sold to third parties. This does not include trusted third parties who assist us in operating the website, conducting our business, or servicing you, so long as those parties agree to keep your personal information confidential. The DCBA may also release your information when it believes release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce DCBA policies, or protect ours or others rights, property, or safety.

As an DCBA member, by default, you may receive any of the following three types of electronic (or email) communication from the DCBA: 1) information and updates pertaining directly to the DCBA (meetings, news, surveys, and other information), 2) information regarding educational opportunities pertinent to beekeeping that are hosted by organizations other than the DCBA, and/or 3) the electronic version of the newsletter.

You may opt not to receive each of these types of communication (1, 2, and/or 3) individually. By default, you will not receive 4) solicitations from companies promoting their beekeeping products that are available for purchase, unless you opt to receive solicitations. The DCBA will not share your personal information with outside educational organizations (2) or solicitors (4); all such communication will come directly from the DCBA.

For any of the above types of electronic communication (1 – 4), your email address may be used by a DCBA Officer (President, Vice Presidents, Treasurer, Secretary, and/or News Letter Editor) and/or a DCBA Webmaster. Approval from the President, Vice President or Secretary will be obtained by the sending officer prior to mailing electronic communications of types 1) or 2) to you. Type 3) or the newsletter does not require approval.

Note: If at any time you would like to unsubscribe from receiving emails regarding any of these types of communications, you may do so on your personal member profile page or by contacting Philip Morris at phil@daviebeekeepers.org.

The DCBA may publish your name, phone number(s), and primary local affiliate chapter in printed form unless you opt to have your information deleted from this publication. Your email address will not be printed or published on the DCBA website unless you are an Officer or Appointee of the DCBA or an Officer of one of its Local Affiliate Chapters.

The DCBA may share your personal information with your appropriate Local Affiliate DCBA Chapter Officers. Otherwise, your email address will not be shared with other DCBA members. The DCBA website may contain links to other websites. Please note that when you click on one of these links, you are entering another website, for which the DCBA is not responsible. By becoming a member of the DCBA, you signify your agreement to our privacy and communication policy as stated above.

Note that this policy may be revised periodically; its current form is available on the DCBA website.
